

CITY OF WELDON SPRING
BOARD OF ALDERMEN WORK SESSION
AUGUST 25, 2022

CALL TO ORDER: A Work Session of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Weldon Spring was held on Thursday, August 25, 2022, at approximately 6:00 PM, at the Weldon Spring City Hall, which is located at 5401 Independence Road. The Work Session was called to order at 6:00 PM by Mayor Licklider.

Alderman Baker, Alderman Clutter, Alderman Conley, Alderman Kolb, Alderman Martiszus, and Alderman Yeager were present. Also, present at the meeting were Michael Padella (City Administrator), and Bill Hanks (City Clerk).

BUSINESS FOR DISCUSSION:

FY 2023 Budget Review & Discussion: Michael Padella (City Administrator) Engineer) presented the budget and went in detail over all the different funds. Next, he provided a summary for the compensation sheet, which included two suggestions made by Alderman Clutter, and the special project spreadsheet for FY 2023. There was a lengthy discussion about the projects the City would be willing to make use of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. The projects discussed included an engineering feasibility study for sewer infrastructure in the Interstate 64 (High-Tech Office) corridor, and a pavilion, restrooms facilities, and event amphitheater at Weldon Spring City Park.

Alderman Baker suggested the culvert lining repairs project on Wolfrum Road. However, Alderman Yeager believes that the ARPA funds should be spent on new infrastructure benefitting residents and not maintenance projects.

The Work Session was adjourned at 7:25 PM.
